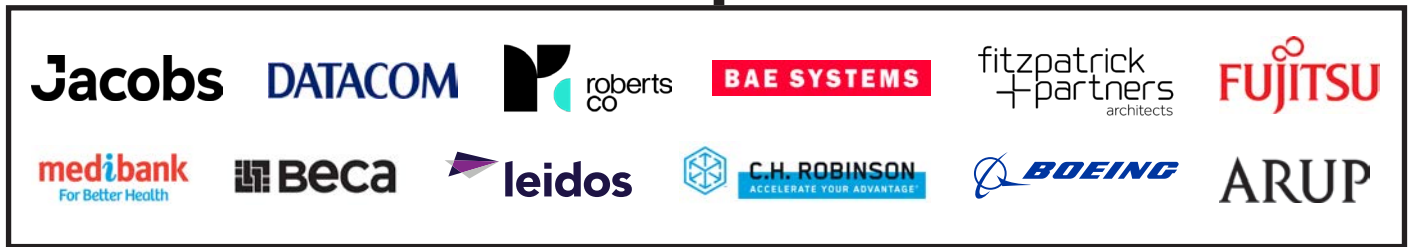

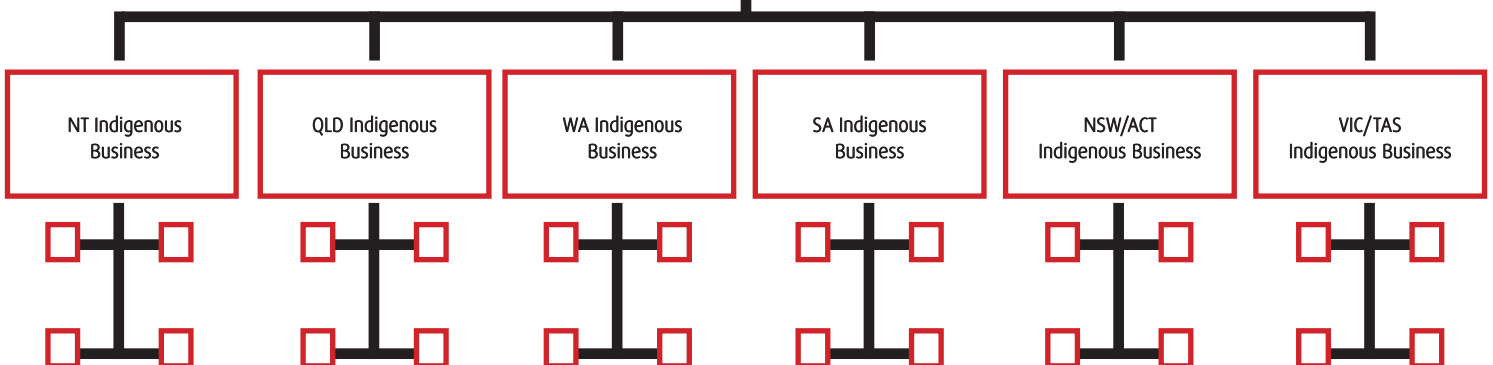

Scope of Work

Facility Services and Construction

Project name: BAE Systems ACT offices construction, Fit out and upgrade

Business reach: Nationwide

Value: \$7.2 Million

Date: January 2020

We were engaged to finalise the design and management of the construction and fit out of two high-end offices. Works included secure zone 4 and zone 5 areas. As head contractor, we are directly engaging and managing all building trades including the procurement and installation of all FFE. iDiC engaged 4 Indigenous businesses in the delivery of this project.

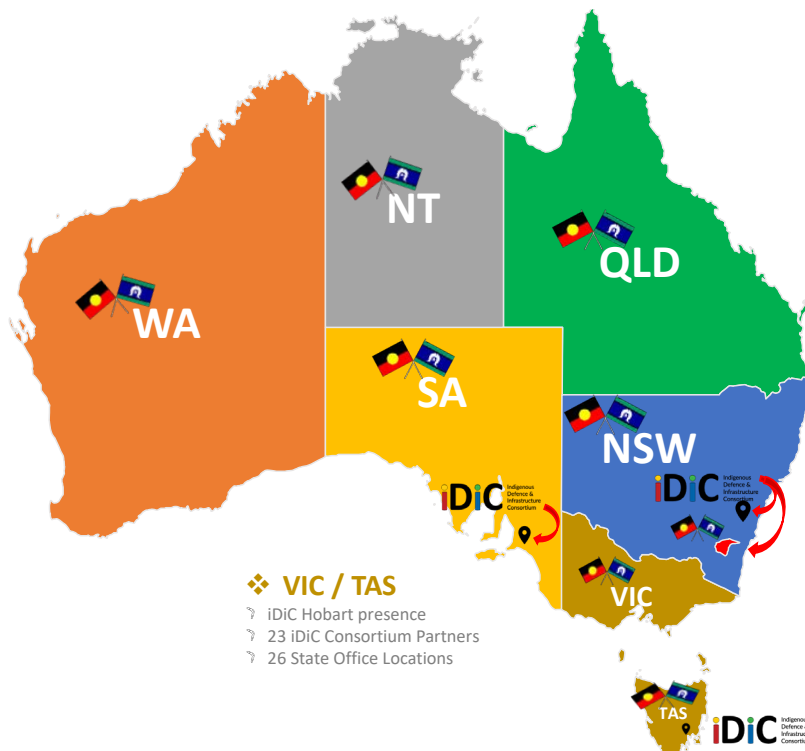
